

# 4.2 Intellectual Property, Patent and Copyright

- 1. Intellectual property created by faculty or staff, or by students working on University research or other University projects, is owned by the University if it is created either:
- (a) within the scope of University employment, including work under University grants and contracts with third parties; or
- (b) with significant use of DUHS Resources.
- 2. If the intellectual property is created outside the scope of University employment and without any significant use of DUHS, the individual will own the intellectual property.

All rights in copyright shall remain with the creator unless the work is a work-for-hire (and copyright vests in the University under copyright law), is supported by a direct allocation of funds through the University for the pursuit of a specific project, is commissioned by the University, or is otherwise subject to contractual obligations.

- DUHS will create intellectual property awareness by conducting information sessions for students,
   faculty, and staff.
- DUHS will facilitate to promote the creation of intellectual property portfolio resulting from research conducted by the DUHS faculty, staff, and students.
- DUHS will assist researchers to search for intellectual property databases.
- DUHS will assist the development of ideas and concepts with a novelty/innovation lens.
- DUHS will assist the preparation of patent applications.
- DUHS will assist filing patents.
