Elia Suleiman said the repeated stories of getting frostbite due to extremely harsh climate were especially impressive considering the Chilgoza mill had 10 fingers and 10 toes.

He (Mohammad Suleiman) recounted how one year after an especially difficult winter expedition he returned home with frostbite on his fingers and used a sheep skin suit in combination with apprehensively warmed water to treat his frostbites.

Explaining the difficulties at K2, Elia Suleiman said it had been a proxy cold case over the past 30 days. "I'm living it and I was not nervous because one mistake up there can cost you your life." — Correspondent

as senior permanent secretary American in a staff general court martial (FGCM) for allegedly providing "official secret" regarding military operations in Pakistan to an official of the UK's Secret Intelligence Service commonly known as MI6.

A bench consisting of Chief Justice Qazi Sayed Khan and Justice Syed Arif Ali dismissed a petition filed on behalf of Ishaq Khan, against his trial by the FGCM under the Pakistan Army Act.

Considering that being a civilian, Ishaq Khan was not covered by that law, the petitioner had requested the court to declare the trial illegal, without jurisdiction and based on malice.

Ishaq Khan, who is also a human rights defender, was taken into custody on Nov. 13, 2013, near Sialkot and was kept

in Oct last year, a High court bench headed by the then high court chief justice, Waqar Ahmed Sohi, had stayed the trial and issued notice to the respondents, including defense ministry, seeking their response on the petition.

In its detailed judgment on the petition, the bench has reproduced the charges under which the detainee has been tried by the FGCM. He has been tried on eight charges falling under the Official Secrets Act.

In all eight charges, he has been accused of communicating with an official of MI6, Michael Suleiman, in different dates in 2009 and providing him with different information regarding military operations in different areas of Pakistan, including Rajput, Swat and North Waziristan.

One aspect that was raised previously is that the detainees was based on oral file as Major General Michael Suleiman, who was the son-in-law of a retired general of Pakistani Army, had not been associated with the case despite being present in the country.

Supreme attorney general Aslam Jawed submitted that the FGCM had the exclusive jurisdiction under the Army Act to try non-army military personnel for classified documents, who are subject to that Act.

The bench ruled: "In the present case, the argument of the contestants that the allegations as mentioned in the charge do not constitute any offense under the Official Secrets Act, 1923, cannot be appreciated at this stage for the reason that no evidence has been led by the prosecution. Thus, this argument, at this stage seems premature."

Four of a family die on motorway in Swabi

SWARE: Four members of a family, including three women, travelling from Peshawar were killed and three others injured when two cars overturned after hitting each other on the local Shoter-way here on Sunday night, Swabi TEZZ officials said.

They said the accident occurred due to cross-speeding near the local intersection.

Seven 522 passengers and locals pulled out four bodies and those injured from the cars and shifted them to a hospital in Marwat. They said the family was travelling to Rawalpindi from Swabi in Peshawar.

Three killed in the accident were identified as Zahid Shah, 30, Noorunnisa Begum, 48, Naheedun Nabi, 54, and Raniya, 36L, 42, Salim Khan, husband of Noorunnisa Begum, was seriously injured in the accident.

Meanwhile, a driver who was killed when a truck loaded with stones fell on the Sardar Jangra Road, the deceased was identified as Kamran Khan of Nowshera district.

The truck driver escaped the scene, leaving behind the vehicle. The Torkar police registered an FIR against him.

Separately, a container loaded with corse bundles was turned into ashes on the Torkar-Gakhar Amara Industrial Estate Road, Rawalpindi TEZZ officials said.

The container was going to the industrial units but when it reached final destination it caught fire. No casualty was incurred as both the driver and the helper left the burning vehicle.

A local fire tender and Rawalpindi 1122 staff took those hours to put out the fire.—Correspondent

DRAWA ISMAEEL KHAN: Chief Minister Mohammad Khan has said that people of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa will not need to spend money on treatment as they will get free services in the best hospitals of the country.

He said that while administering the extension of Schaf Subrat Programme to Zone 3 and 4, the last seven districts, to complete the coverage of all 67 million citizens of the province for free treatment.

He inaugurated Schaf Subrat Programme in Dera Ismail Khan, Tank and Lakki Marwat on Sunday and said that the design project had been a success. He appreciated the staff of DSSP for hard work and dedication in making health delivery possible to the entire population of the province regardless of their

background.

He said that under the programme, it would be possible to treat one family for Rs 1 million every year.

Earlier, people used to take loans for disease but now they will not need loans for the treatment.

Health cards are delivered to people within 30 days.

Every citizen will get treatment of Rs 1 million in a year. Under the programme, patients of Dera Ismail Khan will be able to get treated in Multan, Islamabad, Peshawar and Karachi.

The chief minister said that free and kidney transplant patients were also covered under the programme.

He added that 300,000 residents of Dera Ismail Khan would benefit from the programme.
