A 45 year old female, teacher by profession, c/o increased feeling of tiredness in her arms when she continued to write for some time on blackboard continuously. Her arm dropped by her side and only improved if she rested for some time. On asking, she c/o doubling of objects in her left eye when she continued to look in some direction particularly while watching TV in evening at home; this also improved after she kept her eyes closed for few seconds. She also c/o generalized weakness of all the muscles and drooping of eyelids by the end of the day.
