SBL-III YEAR 2nd WEEK

30 years old housewife, with no co-morbid, admitted via out patient dept. with c/o fever for 1½ months and easy fatigability for 1 month. Fever was sudden in onset, high grade up to 104°F and associated with chills and rigors. It was relieved by antipyretics temporarily, but recurs again. She also received some antimalarial for this fever but with no relief. Later on she gradually developed easy fatigability associated with vertigo and was unable to perform her daily activities. There was NO associated c/o vomiting, diarrhea and cough or bleeding from any other site. In the recent past, she was 3 months pregnant, until around one and half month back, her pregnancy aborted. She when has been transfused with packed cells, recently in private hospital. On examination, her BP is 120/80 mmHg, pulse 120/min regular, R/R 30/min, temp 100°F, there is severe pallor, jaundice and raised JVP up to the angle of mandible and hepatosplenomegally Rest of the systemic examination is unremarkable.
