SCENARIO 1

A 40 year old man presents with gradual, painless, progressive proptosis of LE since six months. On C.T. there are enlarged extra ocular muscles, sparing the tendons.

SCENARIO 2

A 54 year old man presents with progressively worsening pain and swelling around the RE since one week. Both upper & lower eyelids are closed. On past medical history, he had dental extraction about ten days back. VAR is 6/60, RAPD & limitation of ocular movements. On CT, there is opacity behind the septum.
