


# **FACULTY PICTURES**

# **EVENTS INCHARGES**





Students of DUHS lately participated in the public speaking competitions in Lahore. These competitions had been organised at the King Edward Medical University during 14th till 20th and University of Engineering and Technology during 21st till 24th February 2020.

Two teams of DUHS participated in 21st All Pakistan Asian Parliamentary Debate organised at King Edward Medical University, Lahore. The teams actively debated in the four premilinary rounds and DUHS A and DUHS B both won two debates they did. In the preliminary rounds Noor-ul-Elmah Hasan made her place in top 20 best speakers by winning two matches and being the best speaker in both. While all other speakers of DUHS made their place in the top 25 list making us proud once again. The teams DUHS-B consisting of Noor-ul-Elmah, Hafiz Fasih Ahmed and Syed Ibtesam Hashmi and DUHS-A including Taha Ahmed, Syed Zain Ali Shah and S. M. Mairaj ul Arfin were ranked 9th and 10th respectively.

In the \*Declamation Contest at KEMU two teams and two individual speakers participated and the teams of \*Wania Noor & Taha Ahmed and Tooba Ahmed and Syed Ibtesam Hashmi qualified for the final round. \*Taha Ahmed won the competition as the third best speaker in Urdu Serious category.

Students of DUHS also participated in the 27th UET All Pakistan Declamation and Debating championship where two teams, DUHS-A including Taha Ahmed & S M Mairaj ul Arfin and DUHS-B having Noor-ul-Elmah Hasan & Syed Zain Ali Shah participated in the British Parliamentary debate. Team A qualified for the quarter final round in open category as 12th best team in the preliminary round. Two teams of Wania Noor & Syed Ibtesam Hashmi and Tooba Ahmed & Hafiz Fasih Ahmed and an individual speaker Noor-ul-Elmah Hasan\* participated in the Declamation competition where Wania Noor became the finalist in English serious category.



DUHS Literary & Debating Society participated in 20th All-Pakistan Parliamentary Debating Championship at Kind Edward Medical University, Lahore from 26th to 28th April, 2019.

The topics of preliminary matches were announced 30 minutes prior to each match and the teams were supposed to speak either as proposition or opposition which too was disclose at time of announcement of the topics.

This format of debate is known to be the toughest of all formats of speeches due to the topic being a spontaneous and speech being an extemporaneous one.

The DUHS team spoke very well in all the rounds and learnt a lot about how to construct speeches give rebuttals of the opposing team justify their own case as the topics were from diverse background like:

This house believes in the right of Brunei of punish homosexual and adulterers (As Proposition)


