Objectives: After completion of training period, the candidate will be able:

To develop an analytical approach for US guided interventional procedures.

To perform all types of ultrasound guided Biopsies and FNAC including superficial, deep lesions and co-axial techniques.

To perform drainage procedures and catheter insertions.

To perform percutaneous diagnostic and therapeutic procedure.

Limited access to vascular interventional procedures.

Additional responsibilities can be deployed to the candidate, if required by the department.
