
#### REVISED MIGRATION REGULATIONS FOR MBBS & BDS, 2016

- The following categories of students shall NOT be allowed migration: -
  - (i) Those who are admitted against: -
    - (a) reserved seats
    - (b) special seats
    - (c) self-financing seats
  - (ii) Those who are admitted on the basis of merit-cum-choice in the college not tagged to their district of domicile.
  - (iii) Those who are admitted against reciprocal seats in college / institution / institution outside the province of their domicile, including those admitted in FJMC, Lahore.
  - (iv) Those who have not yet passed the first professional MBBS / BDS examination (Part 'A' & Part 'B' both).
  - (v) Students having final aggregate score less than the closing score required for admission to first year MBBS / BDS in the recipient college of the university in that year.
- Those students who do not fall in the above categories may be allowed migration ONLY: -
  - (i) On mutual exchange basis between students of same class and the same category.
  - (ii) Provided expected study period of the student in the recipient college would not be less than one academic year.
  - Migration will be allowed only once during the entire period of medical education of a student.
  - (iv) Any student who migrates unilaterally after clearing all dues to other medical college / institution and seat thus falling vacant on account of this unilateral migration will be fore-feited.
  - Migration fee of Rs. 100,000/- (Rupees One Lac only) will be charged by DUHS to effect migration.
- Migration of students from private medical or dental colleges / universities to DUHS shall be allowed on full fees without any discount after fulfill the codal formalities in the following Colleges of Dow University of Health Sciences: -
  - (i) Dow International Medical College
  - (ii) Dow International Dental College
- All scholarships / financial assistance shall be cancelled once the student migrates to another college / university.
- The migrated student shall not claim any compensation for the loss of time due to difference in starting / ending of academic sessions and in examination schedules between concerned institutions.

- Following procedure / criteria will be observed for migration of children of Pakistani citizens working abroad to DUHS: -
  - (i) He / she will give proof whether his / her college is recognized by the relevant Medical / Dental Council of that Country and its name is incorporated in the Directory of W.H.O.
  - (ii) He / she will give proof that his / her parents at the time of the admission in foreign medical or dental college / institution were settled in that country and that now they stand migrated to Pakistan.
  - (iii) The fee charged by the constituent college of DUHS would be the same as in vogue in the foreign college / university at the time of studentship of the candidate.
  - (iv) The placement of migrated student in a particular class shall be decided by the Equivalence Committee of the university and its decision will be final.
  - (v) He / she will provide certificate from his / her college / university:-
    - (a) that he / she has not been debarred or expelled from the college / university.
    - (b) that no disciplinary action is pending against him / her and
    - (c) that he / she is not repeatedly failing to clear the examination of the college / university.
- \*7. The son / daughter of government servant(s) may be considered for migration, only when: -
  - (i) At the time of admission in the institution where he / she is presently admitted, his / her parent(s) was already posted at the place, and the transfer of the parent(s) was effected after his / her admission. This will not apply to the contract employee.
  - (ii) That his / her family has shifted to Karachi.
  - (iii) That he / she meets minimum eligibility criteria laid down for admission in Dow University of Health Sciences.
  - (iv) That he / she fulfills other conditions as entered into Dow University of Health Sciences Revised Migration Regulations, 2016.
- \*\*8. The son / daughter of Faculty Member / Employee of Dow University of Health Sciences may be considered for migration, only when: -
  - (i) At the time of admission in the institution where he / she is presently admitted, his / her parent(s) was already serving Dow University of Health Sciences as Faculty Member / Employee. This will not apply to the contract employee.
  - (ii) That his / her family has shifted to Karachi.
  - (iii) That he / she meets minimum eligibility criteria laid down for admission in Dow University of Health Sciences.
  - (iv) That he / she fulfills other conditions as entered into Dow University of Health Sciences Revised Migration Regulations, 2016.

# TEACHING SYSTEM AND PROMOTION/DROPOUT CRITERIA

- 1. DUHS, JSMU, KMDC & SMBBMC (Lyari) are following Integrated Modular Teaching System and annual examination.
- PUMHWS (Shaheed Benazirabad) LUMHS Jamshoro, SMBBMU (Larkana) & Gambat Medical College, Gambat are following conventional teaching system and annual examination system.
- 3. Re-admission of students: Any student who fails to clear first or second professional MBBS examination each in four consecutive chances availed or un-availed shall be debarred from continuing medical / dental education in the subsequent professional examinations and re-admission throughout Pakistan. Similarly, any student who fails to clear first professional BDS examination in four consecutive chances availed or un-availed shall be debarred from continuing dental / medical education in the subsequent professional examinations and re-admission through Pakistan.

## **RULES FOR MIGRATION**

The following categories of students will not be allowed migration:

- 1. Those who are admitted against:
  - (a) Reserved/Reciprocal scats
  - (b) Overseas/UEDP/UDP/UEAP under Self-Finance
- Those who are admitted on the basis of merit cum-choice/reciprocal in the university not tagged to their district of domicile including those admitted in FJMC Lahore / BMC Quetta.
- 3. Those who have not passed the First Professional MBBS examination (Parts I and II both) and those who have not passed the First professional BDS examination.
- 4. Migration of students to and from the private medical colleges/universities is not allowed under any circumstances.

Those students who do not fall in the above categories shall be allowed for migration if they fulfill the following requirements:

- 1. NOC from Pakistan Medical Commission (PMC) is mandatory.
- On mutual exchange basis between students of same class after passing (1st Professional Examination Part-1 & II.
- ONCE during the entire period of medical education of a student.
- Student who gets NOC from other recipient university/medical college or provincial government, out
  of Sindh Province, thus the seat falling vacant on this unilateral migration, will be forfeited.
- Migration fee of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Lac Only) will be charged by each university (relieving and admitting) from the student.
- All scholarships/financial assistance shall be cancelled once the student migrates to another college/ institution and is not transferable.
- The migrated student shall not claim any compensation for the loss of time due to differences in starting/ending of academic sessions in examination scheduled between concerned institutions.
- Migration is only possible when there is any vacant seat available in the recipient institute so that the total number of seats does not exceed the designated quota.

PROSPECTUS MBBS & BDS (SESSION 2020-21)

#### Note

- Migration is not possible if the curriculum being followed in both universities is different (Integrated Modular and conventional).
- Migration to public or private medical institution will not be allowed to any student once admitted at Peoples University of Medical & Sciences for Women, Shaheed Benazirabad, and Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto Medical College, Lyari, Karachi.

## MEDICAL BOARD FOR SELECTED CANDIDATES

Selected candidates shall have to undergo a medical examination by a medical board constituted by the university. The selected candidates must produce the following investigations.

- a) X-Ray Chest (PA)
- b) Urine DR
- c) Blood C.P. + ESR
- d) Vaccination certificate against HBV
- e) HBs Ag, HCV Ab
- f) Thalassemia Minor Screening Test
- g) HIV

# SPECIAL MEDICAL BOARD FOR DISABLED CANDIDATES

A Special Medical Board for Disabled Candidates will be constituted in each university to determine the genuineness and severity of the disability of candidate.
